Inauguration of 30 Victoria

Gatineau, October 16, 2014 — Multivesco celebrated obtaining *LEED Canada Core and Shell Platinum Certification* of 30 Victoria, in Gatineau.

This new LEED Platinum building (500, 000 sq. ft.) boasts a state-of-the-art rainwater collection system, a geothermal system, unique insulation standards, an automatic temperature control system, and windows as well as its interior design that optimize access to natural light. It's a flagship of sustainable construction and marks the start of a new era in green building standards.
